To support the implementation of a national policy for libraries in schools at all levels around Cambodia. Sipar has started the mission in 1993 by launching the school library project in collaboration with the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport to set up an extensive network of 300 libraries in primary schools, reinforce school library standards and train the librarians.



LIBRARY SET-UP

Sipar team members are experienced library program managers, trainers, educators and librarians with several years' experiences who will assist on library set-up in schools in all levels.



BOOK AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS DISTRIBUTION

In order to make the libraries more attractive for young readers and satisfy their curiosity, Sipar continue to renew books and education materials in the network of those 300 libraries in primary schools.



CONSTRUCTION

At the request of the local education authorities, Sipar participate to the school's construction in remote areas of Cambodia. Between 1996 and 2021, Sipar has built a total of 38 school buildings.



TRAININGS

We continue share our knowledges on promoting reading to teachers and community volunteers. To maintain the sustainability of our project, we transfer our expertise on library management, storytelling and knowledge on managing an education session as well as the awareness topics to the responsible based in the community.
